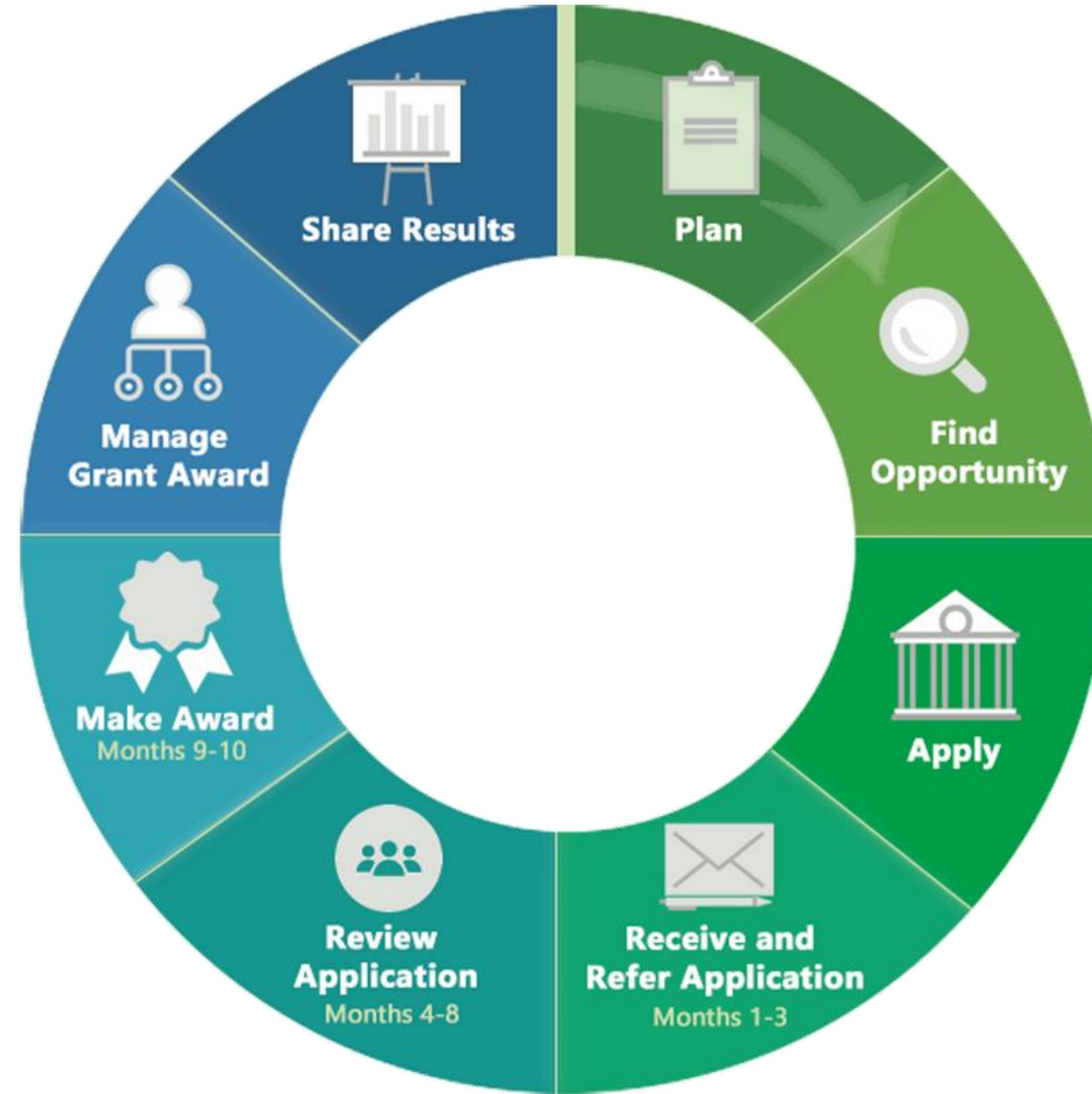
Use Digital Tools to Tell the Story

Planned Preparation

- Start early and be intentional
- Research
 - a. requirements
 - b. Supplement documents
 - c. Necessary Signatures
 - d. Financial statements
- Checklist with due dates
- Editor– language, tone, grammar,
