Giving God Your Thank Offerings

“Sacrifice thank offerings to God, fulfill your vows to the Most High, and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me....He who sacrifices thank offerings honors me, and he prepares the way so that I may show him the salvation of God.” (Ps.50:14, 15, 23)

This is a wonderful time of the year to give thanks to God for the sacrifice of His only begotten Son that we might be reconciled to Him for eternity. I pray that as you intentionally choose to return a sacrifice of thanksgiving this season, He will fill you with new insights about all that the cross means for you and the world. Thanksgiving is such a God-honouring and God-pleasing life-style to develop. It is the opposite of the attitude of those who are spiralling away from God and down into a degenerate lifestyle. Let’s make special efforts to gather with His people to honor Him publicly. Let’s inspire each other with our sacrifices of praise (Heb.13:15).

Yes, there are times we don’t feel like it, but if we make the effort to remind ourselves to give thanks for His goodness, His kindness, His justice, His mercy, His creativity, and His holiness, even the trials and temptations we are sovereignly experiencing, our spirits will be lifted up, our faith will grow, and we will be in a state of being that fully trusts Him with our troubles. Then we can find rest in His promise to answer us, to “save us” amid the challenges of this life. This act of worship prepares us for the eternal aspect of our salvation, and brings further honour to His name here on earth.
